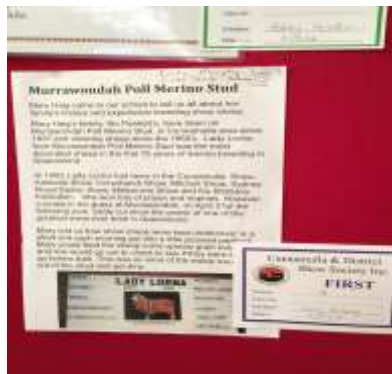

Every Day Counts— Regular School Attendance is very important

As we are nearing the end of Term 2, parents are reminded of the importance of sending children to school on every school day unless there is a reasonable excuse for the student to be away.

Why is regular attendance at school important?

Regular school attendance will mean that your child gets a better chance at life. Your child will achieve better when they go to school all day, every school day:

- they learn better
- they make friends
- they are happier
- they have a brighter future.

Why must I send my child to school?

Under Queensland law, you must make sure your child of school age attends school all day, every school day unless they have a reasonable excuse. Illness, competing in a school sporting event or going on a school excursion are reasonable excuses for being absent from school.

Principals decide if the excuse given for your child's absence is reasonable.

Avoid keeping your child away from school for: Birthdays, shopping, visiting family and friends, if they sleep in, looking after other children, minor check ups or care such as hair cuts.

Routine medical or other health appointments should be made either before or after school or during the school holidays.

Be on Time

I would also like to add that the school day commences at 8.30am and therefore so does the teaching of your child/children. Please be on time.
