### This funding will be used to


- Ensure a smooth and meaningful transition into school from Kindergarten to Prep by supporting children's development and engagement in learning using the Age Appropriate Pedagogies Framework.
- Ensure all students from Prep to Year 6 are making twelve month progress in twelve months, which is outlined in their individualised learning plans.
- Develop staff and student capabilities to effectively engage in online learning in preparation for completing NAPLAN online in 2018 through professional development for staff and explicit teaching of skills for students in all grades.

### Our initiatives include


- A whole school approach to develop and teach Reading, Spelling and Comprehension skills using the Speech Sound Pics (SSP) approach.
- Mapping student progress through the use of the Literacy Continuum and regularly assessing student development and planning for further learning needs.
- Individualised planning and assessment by engaging with Age Appropriate Pedagogy Framework for teaching and learning.
- Interacting with the community, and engaging in community events to provide real-life and life-like experiences to enable students to make links between their curriculum and the real world.
