Review of Eulo's PBL Handbook

Currently, Miss Aish, Miss Tahli and I are reviewing Eulo's Positive Behaviour for Learning Handbook.

This handbook directly links the school's Behaviour Management policy to the explicit expectation of Eulo State School, how we teach desired behaviours and what outcomes can be expected for all types of behaviours.

We will be presenting the behavior matrix and Handbook to the P&C on Thursday 9th March at the first General meeting for the year for community feedback, prior to finalizing the document.

eSmart Framework

Digital technologies are a big part of learning in school, and as such, it is extremely important for children to understand their rights and responsibilities when online.

This year, we will be developing a Eulo State School eSmart policy document and framework, and will present it in an eSmart Handbook, which will also be directly linked the school's Behaviour Management policy.

As with the PBL Handbook, we will be identifying processes and procedures for teaching digital capabilities and responsibilities and publishing these in an eSmart Handbook.
